Salt Lake City is one of only **13** cities in the entire US with a full-time **symphony, opera and ballet.**



Housing and Community Development creates more than **900** units of affordable housing **each year**, creating more than **1,000** construction jobs.



State Library provided **training** to **3,000** library staff from across the state.



In the last **10 years** Utah's general population has grown by **23%**, while those identifying themselves as an ethnic minority have more than doubled.



DCC is the only authority able to identify and **repatriate** sacred Native American remains.



State History tax credit projects totaling **\$41,706,734** last year kept federal tax dollars in Utah and created more than **\$20,000,000** in **local wages** and spent millions of dollars in local purchases.



4.4 M people visited Utah's 250 museums in 81 cities in 24 counties.



HEAT directly assisted more than **50,000** Utah households last year.



State History reviewed **1,895** environmental cases last year in half the allowed time, expediting energy, roads, pipeline and other developments.



Bookmobiles travel **150,000** miles per year offering services to more than **400,000** rural residents.



The Office of Ethnic Affairs facilitates over **80 volunteers** through its boards and advisory councils throughout the state.



Over **400 people** from Utah's **seven** Tribal Nations and state representatives attended DCC and the Governor's 6th Native American Summit.
